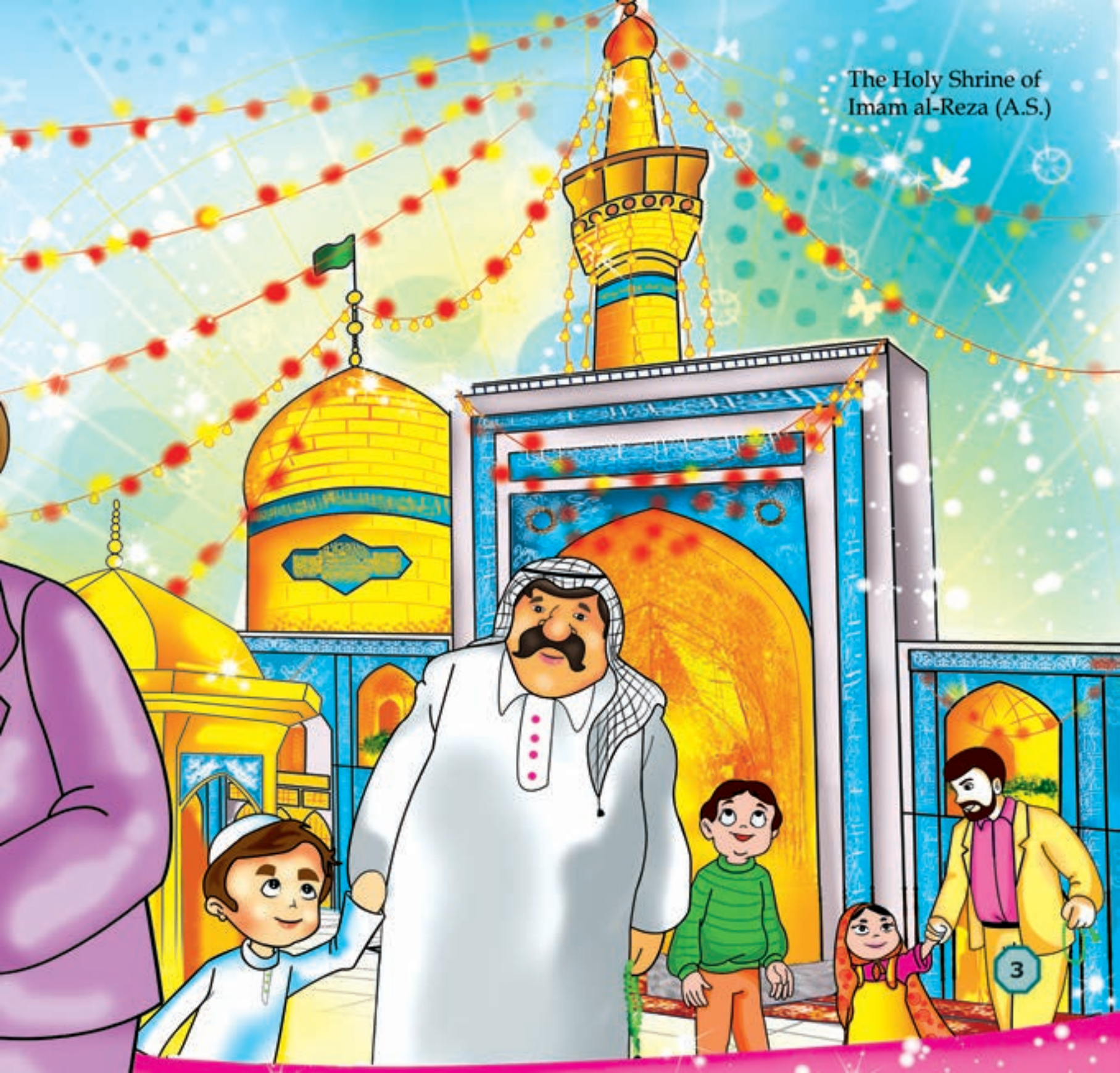

Dear children! Now we are going to introduce some of the religious and cultural places of the Holy Shrine to you.



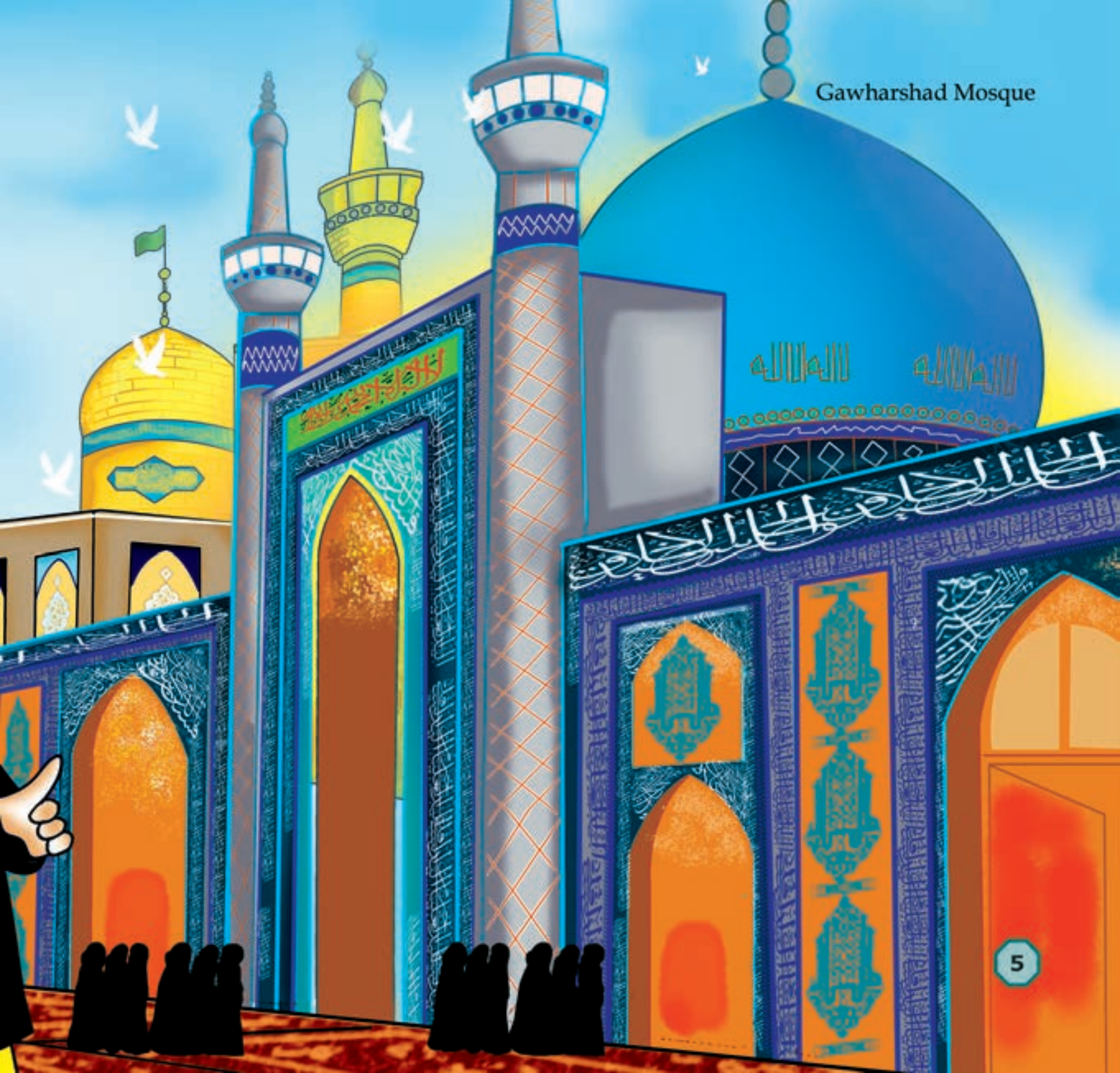

Gawharshad Mosque is one of the best known mosques in Iran. A big azure dome, a courtyard, four porches and seven large prayer halls are among the constructions of this mosque.

This large library has various reading halls. The library receives many interested visitors and members each day.





Jami-i Razavi courtyard is the largest courtyard of the Holy Shrine of Imam al-Reza (A.S.). This courtyard contains three big porches and portals. They are named as Vali-yi 'Asr Porch, Bab al-Kawthat, and Bab al-Qadir. Two lofty minarets have been constructed on both sides of each porch.









Like Jāmi-i Razavī courtyard, Quds Courtyard is also built after the victory of the Islamic Revolution of Iran. The existence of a beautiful water-fountain in the middle of this courtyard brings to mind the memory of the Holy Mosque in Jerusalem.



Holy Mosque in Jerusalem was the first qibla (direction to which Muslims turn in prayer) for the Muslims, which has been occupied by Zionist soldiers for many years.
