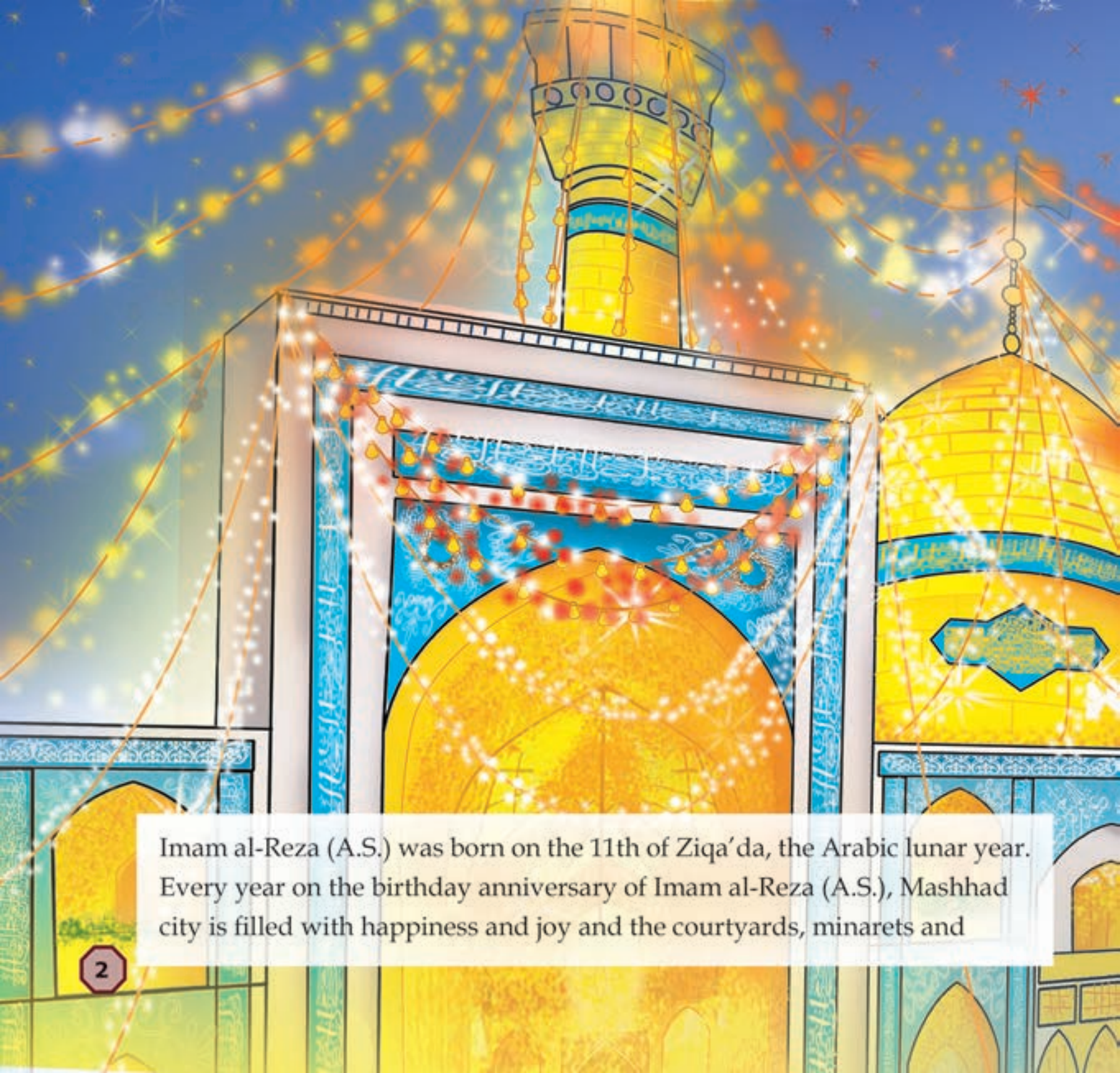
The 10 Days of Generosity

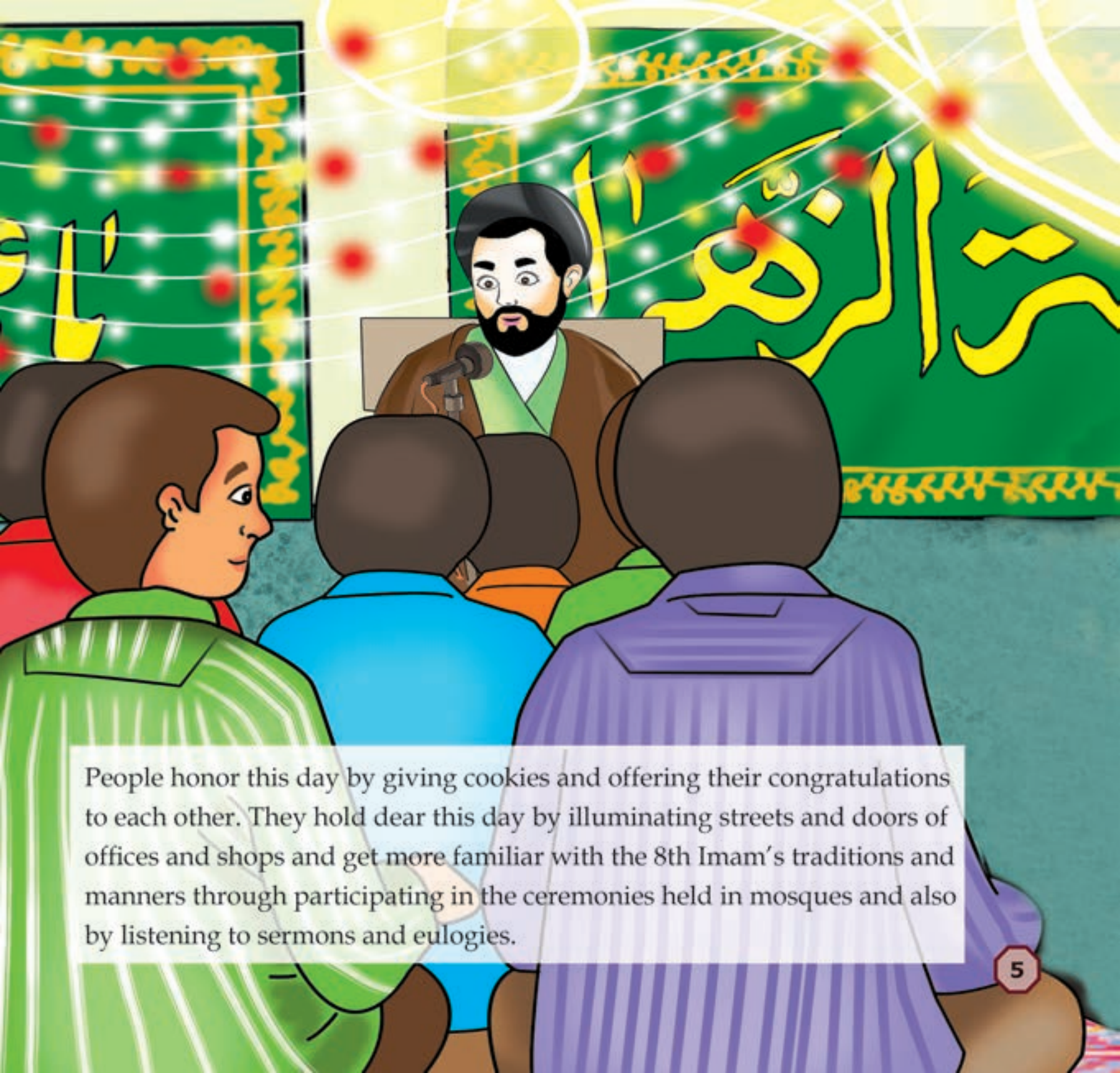

25 years after Imam al-Reza (A.S.) was born, his venerable sister, Her Holiness Hadrat M'asūma (A.S.), was born on the 1st of Ziqā'da 173 lunar year. The 6th of Ziqā'da is also the anniversary of His Holiness Ahmad b. Shah Chiraq, the brother of Imam al-Reza (A.S.) and Her Holiness Hadrat M'asūma (A.S.).
